Public Journalism & Public Opinion

This portion of the table is based on Arthur Charity's *Doing Public Journalism* (1995). Charity, drawing heavily from Daniel Yankelovich's *Coming to Public Judgment: Making Democracy Work in a Complex World* (Syracuse University Press, Syracuse, 1991) proposes a philosophical model of public journalism which, he claims, provides a "powerful example of how insights into the way people make decisions can be turned into concrete newsroom goals for making those decisions easier." (Charity, 1995, p. 4)

MASS OPINION TO PUBLIC JUDGEMENT

Daniel Yankelovich Model of Public Decision-Making: "*An Invitation to Invention*"

Yankelovich's research about what steps public had to pass through to travel from mass opinion (shallow and easily swayed opinions, the pejorative "public opinion" of political diatribes, which can't possibly support democracy) to public judgment (rock solid and unswayed opinions, which can support democracy) and how journalists could make a difference in this process.

I. **Consciousness Raising:** Awareness of an issue's existence and meaning -- Helping the public to set an agenda (Chapter 2) in the absence of obviously important stories/issues/problems

II. **"Working Through":** Confronting the need for change/ options for actions

- Reducing issues to choices (Chapter 3)
- Plumbing to core values
- Spelling out the costs and consequences of each choice
- Bridging the expert-public gap
- Facilitating deliberation (Chapter 4)
- Promoting civility

III. **Resolution:** The actual making of a stable, responsible choice
